

Eyedog – Safe lifting of bundles

The new IronGrip Eyedog automatically secures a wire rope sling for lifting pipe bundles or other stacks of goods.

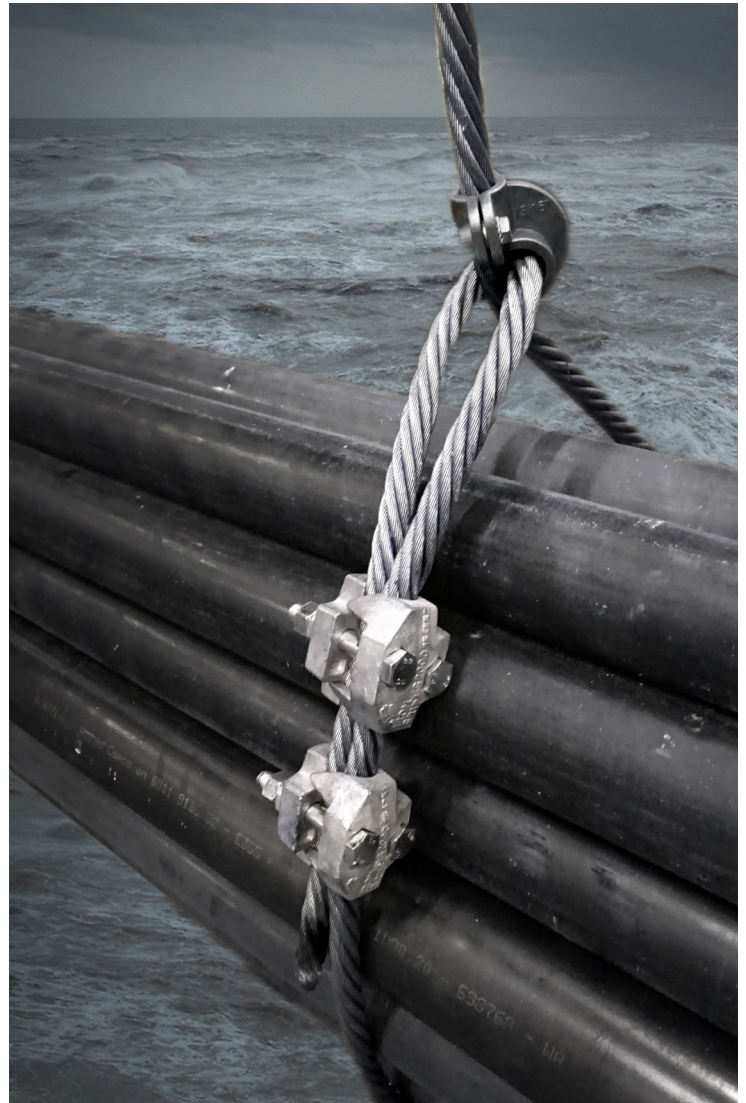
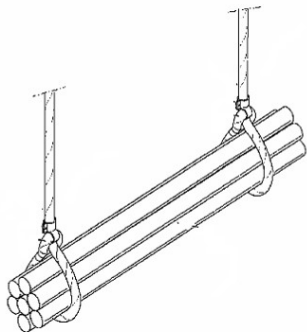
The Eyedog is easily fitted on the lifting end of the wire by tightening a screw and by hooking it onto the eye of the sling when it is unloaded. When the sling is lifted, the Eyedog runs along the lifting part of the sling securing the grip around the bundle.

When the bundle is put down and tension is released in the sling, the Eyedog prevents the sling from opening up. The ingenious design of the Eyedog makes it grip hold as the wire expands slightly when tension is released.

The bundle can be opened in a controlled fashion by releasing the screw of the Eyedog so that it gradually releases its grip of the wire.

The Eyedog improves safety when lifting pipe bundles since it is fitted when the sling is unloaded, automatically tightens the sling and gives full control of the release.

Also, the the Eyedog makes it possible for the sling to remain on the bundle until next lift. Both sling and Eyedog can even be reused several times since the Eyedog keeps the sling from being damaged when bundles are stacked on top of each other.
